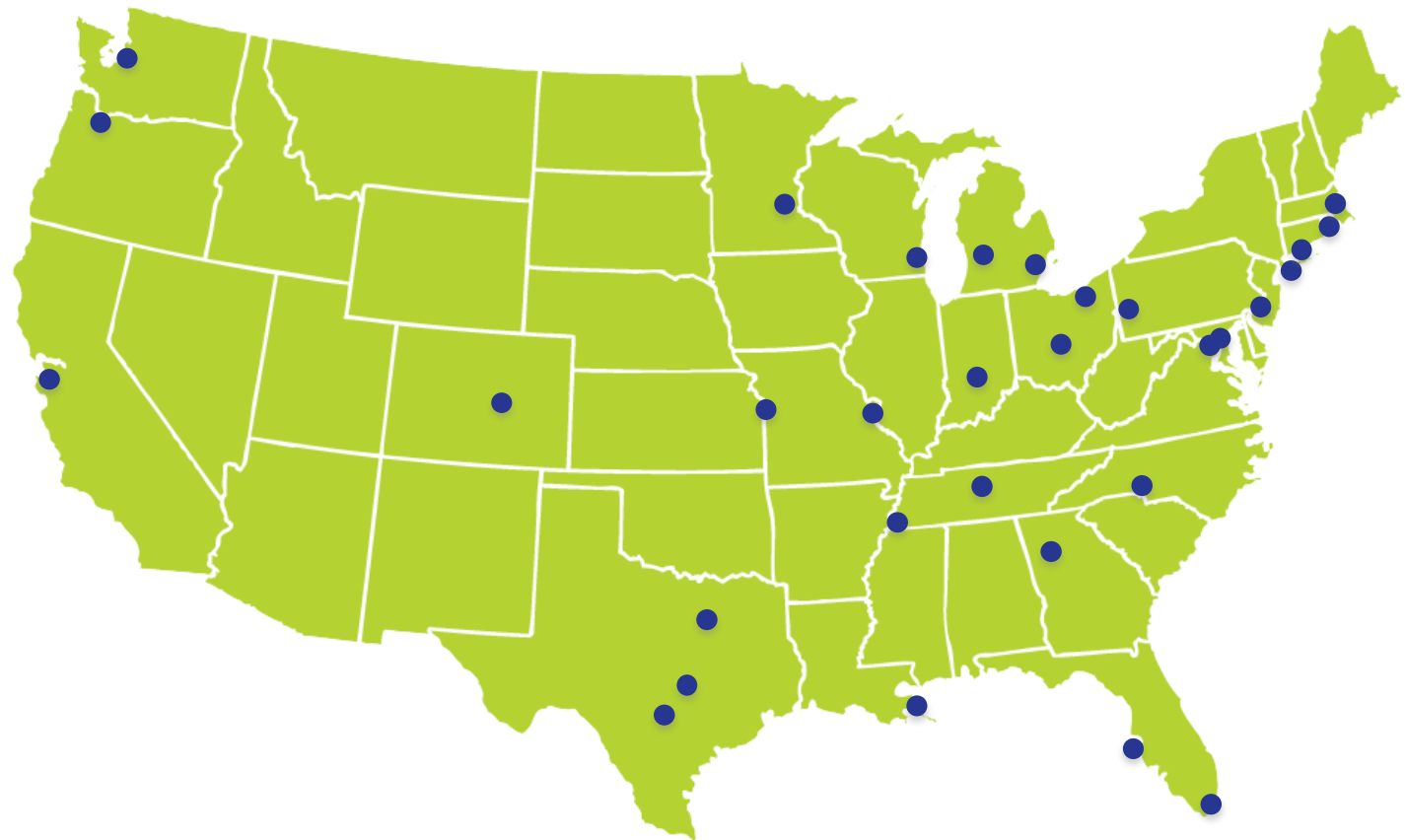

How do we achieve this?



- Pilots a research model that monitors neighborhood change
- Motivations:
 - Drive informed government action
 - Support displacement prevention
 - Promote inclusive revitalization

Key Design Elements

- Topical exploration of various types of displacement
- Qualitative and quantitative data collection
- Practical application of research through advisory committee & communications plan
- Participation in cross-site exchange facilitated by Urban and FPI

Project Goals



- Develop meaningful and more frequent metrics
- Facilitate community conversations
- Advance the state of the field
- Share strategies
- Produce protocols and methodology
